End of Season Wrap Up!! Please take a moment to read through this note and fill out and return the attached forms. As always, we are greatly indebted to you for making the commitment to have your child in CDCC. We hope to see you again next season!!!

2019-2020 AUDITIONS: Know someone who loves to sing? Give them the attached postcard and invite them to audition for CDCC! Thanks for helping us spread the word!!!

NOTE: CURRENT CDCC choir members do not need to schedule an audition unless their choir director specifically asks them to do so. If your child is currently in 4th, 6th, or 9th grade, they will audition for next year's choir during one of their current choir's regularly scheduled rehearsals. Current Angelica singers who would like to audition for Cantus will audition with Mr. Seil during a regular Angelica rehearsal. Singers currently in 3rd, 5th, 7th, 8th, 10th or 11th grade remain in their current choir and, therefore, do not need to re-audition. **ALL current CDCC singers MUST complete the attached Letter of Intent and return to their director or the choir office by April 18.**

IMPORTANT! The auditions of all current 9th grade girls, whether new to CDCC or current members, will be an audition for Angelica. That audition will also serve as an audition for Cantus, with the understanding that participation in Angelica as a 10th grader is a prerequisite for participation in Cantus. i.e., Angelica is a 10th grade girl's primary choir and Cantus, if invited to participate, is her secondary choir. All 10th grade girls must be members in good standing of Angelica in order to be eligible for invitation to Cantus.

Reminder: All Kantorei, Angelica, and Cantus singers must be enrolled in their school choir in order to participate in CDCC.

ATTACHED FORMS:

- **Letter of Intent:** (white form) Please be sure to fill out your letter so we can hold your spot for next year. The letter of intent can also be completed online at www.aboutcdcc.org. **(Due April 18)**
- **Evaluations:** (white form) Please take a moment and complete our choir evaluation. We are always looking for ways to improve CDCC and the only way we can do this is with your feedback. Everyone's opinion is important to us and we read each and every evaluation that comes in. **(Due May 12)**
- **Memory Book Form and Orders:** (green forms) This is a keepsake that the choir puts together for the children. If you are interested, please fill out an order form. Even if you choose not to purchase a book, please make sure your child completes their Memory Book Form, as we want to include everyone in the book. **(Due May 12)**
- **Video Orders:** (salmon form) D&N Cinematics will be filming our Saturday, May 11 Spring Concert. You may purchase a recording of the concert on either Blu-ray (\$20) or DVD (\$15). **(Due May 12)**
- **CD Orders:** (yellow form) Dave DeRung will be recording our Saturday, May 11 Spring Concert. The cost of the CD is \$15.00. Please make this check out to Dave DeRung—not to CDCC. **(Due May 12)**

Take Note: You may combine anything that is made out to CDCC in one check. HOWEVER, please, please, please (did I say please?) staple your check to your order or orders. If you send cash, please note it on your order form and place it in an envelope along with the completed order forms. You will need to send the correct cash amount because the directors will not have change.

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SPRING CONCERT:

Tickets: Our spring concert dates are Saturday, May 11 at 7:30 pm and Sunday, May 12 at 2:00 pm at the Belle Mehus. Tickets are available at Eckroth Music, at the choir office, and online at www.aboutcdcc.org. They will also be available the day of the concerts at the box office which opens one hour before the concert. This is our last performance of the season and a very exciting one for us. The concerts will feature performances by each of CDCC's five choirs with a special performance by CDCC's pre-choir, Singing for 2nd Graders, during Sunday's concert.

2019-2020 SEASON INFORMATION:

Notification Letters: Every singer, whether moving to a new choir or staying in their current choir will receive a notification letter in the mail by May 20. If your child plans to participate in CDCC and you do not receive a letter, please contact the choir office immediately.

Registration: Returning members will need to complete registration for next year between the dates of May 23 and June 14. All information regarding next season (dates, costs, uniforms, etc.) will be in the registration packet. You may either stop by the choir office during regular hours to complete registration or complete it online at aboutcdcc.org.

CDCC Uniform Sale: If you would like to sell your child's uniform on consignment, you may bring it to the choir office from May 23-June 4. Office hours are Mondays - Thursdays from 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m., we are closed on Fridays. The choir office is located at the Frances Leach High Prairie Arts & Science Complex located at 1810 Schafer Street. (Note: The office will be closed Monday, May 27 for Memorial Day.)

You will need to launder all garments (most are machine washable) for our office to accept your garments. We have been very lax in the enforcement of this request in the past, but due to a large number of items being brought in unlaundered we will be checking this more closely this year. **Please do not bring soiled items.** The choir reserves the right to refuse garments that are not clean and in good condition.

A processing fee will be deducted from the price of your sale. Payment for articles that sell during Used Uniform Sale will be sent in November.
