

Student Responsibilities

In order to provide a pleasant and enjoyable tour for everyone involved, the following rules and guidelines must be followed:

The entire tour is considered an extension of choir rehearsal.

1. Follow all rules of common courtesy and respect for others at ALL times. Insubordination will not be tolerated.
2. Respect for the property of others is a must. This includes all property on the premises of wherever we go. Property of motels, restaurants, and other places we visit is not “souvenir” material unless you make arrangements to pay the establishment for them.
3. Anyone involved in the use of tobacco, drugs, or alcohol will be expelled from the tour and sent home at their own or their parent/guardian’s expense.
4. All tour participants must dress neatly and appropriately at all times and treat all supervisors and all people involved with respect. No caps or headwear may be worn indoors. We want to exhibit class wherever we go. We will not promote any messages for the liquor or tobacco companies, or questionable rock groups. Tour participants must comply with the chaperone’s and the director’s judgment on any of these issues.
5. All choir members must wear their CDCC t-shirts, sweat shirts, or polo shirts when traveling and whenever otherwise designated.
6. All tour participants must use language which is becoming of young ladies and gentlemen. The use of foul language or inappropriate conversation will not be tolerated, and neither will the possession of questionable or pornographic materials. Movies viewed on the bus must be “G” or “PG” rated.
7. No wandering off by yourself.
8. No males in the girls’ rooms, and no girls in the boys’ rooms.
9. If anyone is uncomfortable with actions or intentions of another during the trip, it should be reported to the chaperone immediately.
